A Year in Review: Our After-School Program

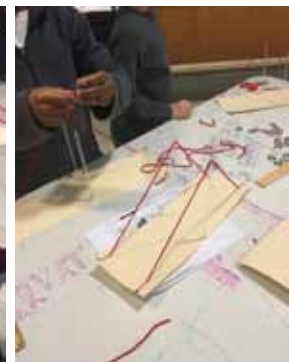
Last fall, Morrow Church expanded its community outreach by partnering with Seth Boyden Elementary School to offer students an after-school STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) enrichment program. We kicked off the school year by exploring EZ Science, studying science basics as we created our own science journals. Then we moved on to learning the physics of motion as we explored and experimented with fun hands-on activities. Our students built catapults and bridges and even dropped eggs off buildings!

Throughout our explorations, as part of the inventors program, our 18 third- and fourth-graders looked at engineering and math from the perspective of inventions that make the world work better. In addition, our students took on the First Lego Challenge, working together in teams to imagine and create future places of learning.

Thanks to our amazing volunteers, leaders, and snack providers, we are proud to report that Morrow Church's pilot program will be continuing next year!
