


## Morrow is Green!

In a collaboration between the Green Team, Building and Grounds Committee and The Board of Trustees, Morrow Church has reduced the carbon footprint from its electricity consumption by 30% over the last 5 years.

This reduction was achieved by replacing inefficient lighting throughout the building with modern, energy efficient lighting.



## Next: Make a Matching Donation from the Sun

Morrow is installing solar panels on the roofs of Fellowship Hall and the Kitchen in spring of 2019.

The solar panels will produce half of Morrow's current electrical need and will save the church \$190,000 over the expected life span of 25 years. In addition, Morrow will receive \$60,000 over the next 10 years in Solar Renewable Energy Credits.
