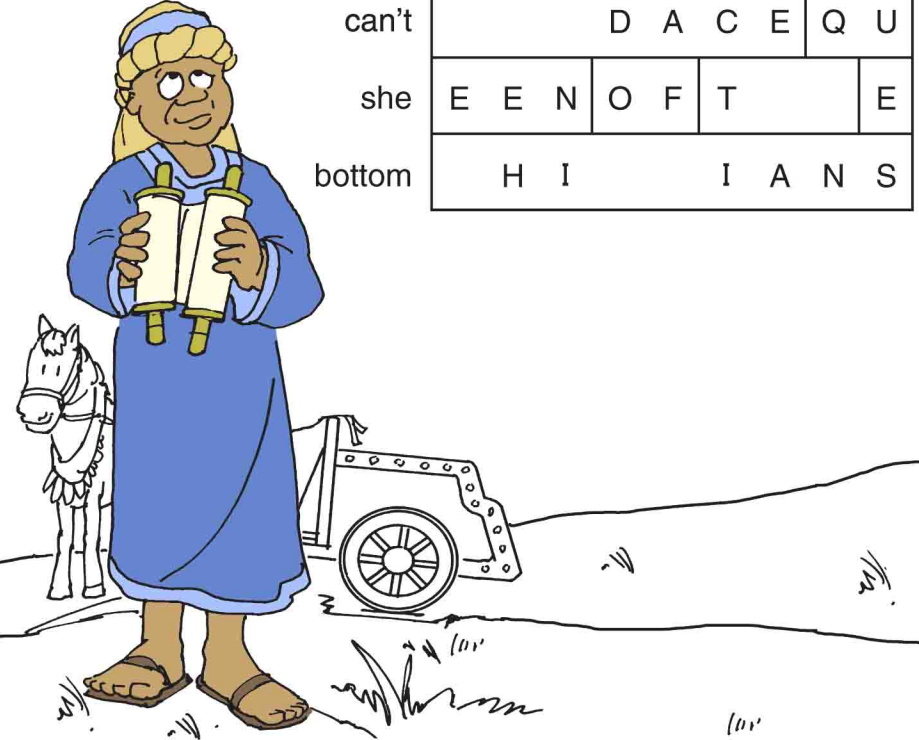


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The man in the chariot had been to Jerusalem to worship God. Philip was sent to tell him the good news about God's Son Jesus.
